The Swansea Town Council held their monthly General Meeting at the Swansea Municipal Building, Courtroom, 320 West Third Street, Swansea, South Carolina 29160.

General Meeting

Mayor Sanders called the meeting to order at 6:00pm. The media was notified and the agenda of the meeting was posted at Town Hall and at the Swansea Police Department. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all present. Councilman Woodrow Davis was ask to lead the Prayer.

Mayor Sanders called for the consideration of a motion on the minutes of June 18th, 2018 General Meeting and the Special Called Meeting of June 22nd, 2018. Councilman Michael Luongo made the motion to accept the minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Councilman Davis and passed by a unanimous vote.

Mayor and Council Comments

Mayor Sanders stated that the Community Crime Watch Committee was organized. Ms. Melissa Williams was elected new chairwoman to head up that group.

There were about 25 residents in attendance. The group will meet again August 14th, 2018 at 6:30pm at the Senior Center in Swansea. No other council members had comments.

Water And Sewer Department Report

Rick Bryan stated for the month of June we had no violations to report. Councilman Luongo ask about the amount of water lost for the month. Rick indicated that it was less than 10%.

Street Maintenance

Carlton Moore was not in attendance. Mayor Sanders informed the council of his conversation with a representative of Advance Disposal regarding garbage pickup. The services rendered by Advance Disposal was not acceptable to the Town of Swansea. And if the poor services rendered by Advance Disposal was not fixed in a week, the town would terminate the services of Advance Disposal immediately .

Police Report

Chief Hayes presented stats for last month. He shared 72 citations, 4 accidents, 14 warrants, and 13 arrests. 2 new vehicles were ordered and on the way to be added to the Police fleet.

Melissa Williams newly elected chairwoman of the Crime Watch Committee presented its first meeting results to council.
